Scholarship/Research Development Committee

Charges:

1. Working with the Program Committee and with AACP staff, begin to offer the ACCP Research Certificate program to Section members, starting with the 2011 Annual Meeting. (Goal 4.2)
2. Investigate the development of a research grant award program for new and mid-career pharmacy practice faculty. (Goal 4.2)
3. In cooperation with the Communications Committee, and based upon the work of the 2009-2010 Scholarship/Research Development Task Force, implement an electronic newsletter dedicated to pharmacy practice research and scholarship for current Section members, pharmacy practice faculty who are not Section members, and potential pharmacy practice faculty members (e.g., residents, fellows, graduate students). (Goal 4.2)
4. In conjunction with the Faculty Development Committee, begin the process to develop a practice-based research development/mentorship program. (Goal 4.2)
5. Submit an interim and an annual report for inclusion in the Section business meetings at the 2010 ASHP Midyear and 2011 AACP Annual Meetings, respectively.

This is just to give you a quick update as our committee work has been relatively silent since completing the New Investigator Program Evaluation Form. I have a meeting today with June Johnson and Lucinda Maine to discuss Charge #1 regarding the ACCP Research Certificate Program. Lucinda is going to update both June and I and we will then develop a plan of action for our two committees to collaboratively work together to provide assistance. In addition, I have a tentative meeting set with Leigh Ann Ross from the Communications Committee the week of November 29th in order to discuss and develop a plan of action for Charge #3 related to the electronic newsletter.
