Charges:

1. Development of a revised Caring for the Underserved Curriculum Framework (consider new format) based on feedback received at the 2010 AACP Annual Meeting.
2. The committee should plan for special sessions/roundtables at the 2011 AACP Annual meeting to assist faculty interested in or engaged in caring for the underserved in networking and establishing collaborative connections with their peers. Communicate planning with the SIG's Program Committee.
3. Development of caring for the underserved competency statements document to assist schools/colleges of pharmacy in curriculum mapping. This document should be aligned with relevant academic pharmacy standards/guidelines.
