

Faces of Change for Pharmacy Practice Project

Description

AACP's Council of Deans Task Force on Innovations in Pharmacy Health Care Education is pleased to announce the opportunity for each School/College of Pharmacy to participate in a project designed to assist in advancing the innovations in pharmacy education. This is a chance to showcase your school/college's educational program. "Faces of Change for Pharmacy Practice" provides the opportunity for students to submit a video about educational experiences (e.g. courses, experiential learning, co-curricular, and extracurricular activities) in your pharmacy program. Students should address some unique aspect of their program that has created a sense of responsibility and empowered them as individuals to lead change in pharmacy practice.

How will the submissions be used?

The project is a social experiment that could be helpful to the entire pharmacy education community. All entries will be posted on a web site which will be available to all pharmacy education programs. Excerpts from selected entries will be shown at the 2010 Annual Meeting in Seattle.

Rules

- Participating colleges/schools may submit as many entries as they wish. However, when more than one video is submitted the college/school must rank them in order of preference.
- The dean's approval/signature is required on the submission form for each video.
- Each video must clearly identify the institution, title of the video and names of participants including any faculty member(s) advising students.
- Video must not exceed two minutes in length.
- Students are encouraged to not script their comments.
- Student participants must generally agree that changes in pharmacy practice are required to ensure the optimal use of medications to improve patient care outcomes.
- Specifically, applicants must address: "What unique experiences has your school or college provided to prepare you in leading change in pharmacy practice?"

Submission Package

The package should contain the following:

- One submission form signed by the dean for each digital video (MS Word, PDF or TXT file types preferred)
- Any format of digital recording

Submissions materials must be received by May 31, 2010. HSOP can accept movie and document files via FTP. You will need an FTP client to connect to our FTP server. We recommend FileZilla if you do not currently have a way to send files via FTP. You may download FileZilla for free from www.downloads.com
