Acknowledgement of receipt, as well as notification of acceptance or rejection of abstracts in mid-April, will be sent via e-mail to the primary author. Accepted abstracts will be posted on the

AACP Web site in May 2008 and in the winter supplement of the *American Journal of Pharmaceutical Education*.

Online Annual Meeting School Poster Abstract Submission Now Open

AACP/AFPC Annual Meeting school poster abstracts can be submitted online at <http://www.allacademic.com/one/aacp/aacp08/>. The topic selected for this year's school posters should relate to curricular and co-curricular efforts in the areas of public health, wellness and prevention. Details for the school poster abstract criteria are available on the [AACP Web site under Meetings, 2008 Annual Meeting and Seminars](#). Each institution may submit up to two poster abstracts on a first come, first served basis due to space constraints. The CEO dean must authorize each abstract's inclusion by signing and returning a verification form. Verification forms are available on the online submission site and the AACP Web site. **Deadline to submit school poster abstracts is Friday, March 14.** Please note that CEO Deans recently received notification about submitting school posters.
