 - e: Students admitted directly from high school or as freshmen prepharmacy and given an official guarantee of admission pending successful completion of any stated contingencies, into the first year of the professional pharmacy degree program.
 - f: Baccalaureate degree recommended
 - g: Candidates enrolled in one of the 3/3 dual degree programs at one of our affiliated institutions are guaranteed an interview and receive priority consideration for admission.
 - h: Dual Acceptance Programs
 - i: We have affiliation agreements (guaranteed admission programs) with Eastern Illinois University, Northern Illinois University, Western Illinois University, Illinois State University, University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign.
 - j: Students spend four years completing Drake's professional PharmD program. Applicants must complete 63 semester credit hours, including prerequisite courses, prior to the fall 2016 semester.
 - k: Direct-entry admission into the first professional (P1) year of the program is offered only through PharmCAS. Students must have completed a bachelor's degree (in any field) and all prerequisite course requirements, and must take the PCAT exam.
 - l: Our program structure is 0-6 (no prepharmacy requirements), but we also take transfer students in the third year (professional year 1).
 - m: A cooperative pharmacy program open to students in Southern New Mexico counties. Students are admitted as high school seniors, complete 3 years of prerequisites and are admitted to the Pharm.D. program, if benchmarks are attained.
 - n: 0-7 (no prepharmacy requirements); 72+ semester hours required for admission for non-0-7 students to backfill
 - o: Ursuline College/University of Toledo Partnership, Owens Community College/University of Toledo Partnership
 - p: Weekend Pharm.D. requires a Baccalaureate Degree
 - q: Distance Education Pathway
 - r: Students living in the 37 border counties of Texas may become part of the Cooperative Pharmacy programs between UT Austin and UT Pan American and UT El Paso.
