

Call for AJPE Associate Editor

The *American Journal of Pharmaceutical Education* (AJPE) is seeking an Associate Editor to serve with the Editorial Team, comprised by the Editor, Executive Associate Editor, Associate Editors, and Editorial Staff. The Associate Editor will be responsible for various aspects of journal operations and performance, including but not limited to, recruiting high-quality manuscripts from authors on teaching and the scholarship of teaching and learning, coordinating the manuscript review process of new and revised submissions, and making timely decisions regarding acceptance for publication in various disciplines. The Associate Editor will participate in meetings with the Editorial Team and Editorial Board and represent the Journal at AACP's annual meetings. The AJPE Editorial Team will conduct the selection process of the new Associate Editor. This Associate Editor will serve an initial three-year term with an option for reappointment. Associate Editors for AJPE may not serve on boards of other journals during their term.

Selection Criteria

This Associate Editor is expected to provide leadership and vision that further the aims and goals of AJPE. The principal criteria for selection are as follows:

- A record of publishing in AJPE and other scholarly peer-reviewed journals.
- A record of serving as a reviewer for AJPE or other scholarly peer-reviewed journals.
- Written and verbal communication skills sufficient to and a willingness to work with manuscript authors and with the Editorial Team and Editorial Board members.

This is a voluntary, unpaid position, but the individual will be provided with a small stipend, registration for the American Association of Colleges of Pharmacy Annual Meeting, and business cards for use at other meetings.

Application Process

Interested individuals should provide a cover letter specifically outlining their qualifications for serving as an Associate Editor and a copy of their current curriculum vitae as a single PDF file by 5:00 pm on Friday, January 10, 2025, to brazeau@marshall.edu.
