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## About the AACP Curriculum Quality Surveys

Graduating Student, Alumni, Preceptor, and Faculty surveys were first released in 2007 based on Standards 2007 with the purpose of helping member colleges and schools gather data for both continuous improvement and accreditation purposes. With the release of the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education (ACPE) Standards 2016, these curriculum quality perception surveys were revised by the AACP Institutional Research and Assessment Committee (IRAC), AACP staff, and ACPE staff in spring 2015 to reflect the changes in Standards 2016. The 2018 results reflect the third administration of these revised surveys.

## 2018 Administration

The Faculty Survey was made available for online access in the AACP Survey System on March 5,2018 . As of July 2018,111 out of 143 ( $77.6 \%$ ) colleges and schools of pharmacy administered the survey to their faculty. A total of five thousand, one hundred and eightynine $(5,189)$ faculty were invited to complete the survey. Three thousand, seven hundred and nineteen $(3,719)$ faculty submitted the survey for a total response rate of 71.7 percent ( $71.7 \%$ ). Response rates per school ranged from 8.1 percent to 100 percent. ## Faculty Satisfaction with Administration and Governance

In 2018, nearly 82 percent of faculty ( $81.6 \%$ ) strongly agreed or agreed that their college or school's dean was an effective leader. 77 percent ( $77.0 \%$ ) of faculty strongly agreed or agreed that administrators function as a unified team, representing a four point increase from 2017 ( $74.1 \%$ ). Nearly 81 percent ( $80.9 \%$ ) strongly agreed or agreed that administrators were aware of their needs/problems and over 74 percent ( $74.4 \%$ ) strongly agreed or agreed that administrators were responsive to these needs/problems. Over 67 percent (67.3\%) strongly agreed or agreed that they were given the opportunity to provide evaluative feedback to administrators, however 28.1 percent ( $28.1 \%$ ) strongly disagreed or disagreed with this statement.

## Faculty Development and Performance

Nearly 90 percent ( $89.9 \%$ ) of faculty strongly agreed or agreed that they had access to documents that detail policies related to their performance as a faculty member. However, fewer faculty ( $80.3 \%$ ) strongly agreed or agreed that their performance assessment criteria were explicit and clear. The number of faculty who strongly agreed or agreed that they received guidance on career development remained at similar levels from 2017 (66.1\%) to 2018 (66.7\%).

## College/School Infrastructure

95 percent ( $95.0 \%$ ) of faculty strongly agreed or agreed that their campus work environment was safe, a similar level reported in 2017. Over 79 percent ( $79.2 \%$ ) strongly agreed or agreed that the college had physical facilities to effectively support academic program needs. However, only 64 percent ( $63.5 \%$ ) strongly agreed or agreed that the college/school had a sufficient number of faculty.

## Curriculum and Teaching

Eighty-eight percent (88.1\%) of faculty strongly agreed or agreed that curricular collaboration among disciplines was encouraged at their college/school. Eighty-one percent (81.4\%) strongly agreed or agreed that the college/school used programmatic assessment data to improve their curriculum, representing a one point increase from 2017 ( $80 \%$ ).
