



## **PHARMACY FACULTY SURVEY PUBLIC SCHOOL SUMMARY REPORT - 2013**

The Faculty Survey was available for online access in the AACCP Centralized Survey System on March 11, 2013. As of July 2013, 38 public colleges and schools of pharmacy administered the survey to their faculty. Two thousand and fifteen (2,015) faculty at public schools were invited to complete the survey. One thousand, five hundred and twenty-nine (1,529) faculty at public schools submitted the survey for a total response rate of nearly seventy-six percent (75.9%). Response rates per school ranged from 53.2 percent to 100.0 percent.
