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Pharmacy Demand Report (PDR) Executive Summary

4th Quarter 2020

This is the executive summary of the Pharmacy Demand Report (PDR) for the fourth quarter 2020. An overview of the PDR can be found [online](#).

Pharmacists

There have been 12,639 job postings for pharmacists through the fourth quarter 2020. Highlights for pharmacist job postings for 2020 include:

- 5,260 job postings were reported for the first quarter (which includes carry over postings from 2019), 2,115 job postings were reported for the second quarter, 2,526 job postings were reported for the third quarter and 2,743 job postings were reported for the fourth quarter;
- The highest number of job postings are in the southern and western parts of the country, followed by the Midwest and northeast;
 - In the third quarter 2020, the highest number of job postings were reported in the south, followed by the west, Midwest and northeast;
- California continues to have the highest number of job postings (2,232), followed by Florida (1,090), Texas (940), and Ohio (726). Vermont has the lowest number of job postings (6);
 - In the fourth quarter 2020, the highest number of job postings were reported in California, followed by Florida, Texas, Georgia, and Ohio;
- The MSAs with the highest number of job postings in the first quarter were Los Angeles, New York-Newark, and Chicago; the top MSAs in the second quarter were New York-Newark, Los Angeles, and Sacramento; the top MSAs in the third quarter were Los Angeles, Miami-Fort Lauderdale, and New York-Newark; and the top MSAs in the fourth quarter were Los Angeles, New-York-Newark, and Miami-Forth Lauderdale; and
- The highest number of postings are for the Clinical Pharmacist position (4,818) followed by the Retail Pharmacist position (3,922), the Other Pharmacist Occupations category (2,366), the Hospital Pharmacist position (914), and the Pharmacy Director position (619).

Pharmacy Technicians

There were 145,216 pharmacy technicians through the fourth quarter 2020. Highlights for pharmacy technicians for 2020 include:

- 48,445 job postings were reported for the first quarter (includes carry over postings from 2019), 28,664 job postings were reported for the second quarter, 29,036 job postings were reported for the third quarter, and 39,071 job postings were reported for the fourth quarter;
- The highest number of job postings continue to be in the southern part of the country, followed by the west, Midwest, and northeast;
- California has the highest number of job postings (14,588), followed by Texas (11,654), Florida (8,911), and Arizona (7,997). Wyoming had the lowest number of job postings (111);
 - In the fourth quarter 2020, the highest number of job postings were reported in California, Texas, Florida, and Arizona; and
- New York-Newark had the highest number of job postings for the first and second quarters. For the first quarter, the top MSAs also included Chicago, Los Angeles and Dallas-Fort Worth. For the second quarter, the top MSAs were Los Angeles, Chicago, and Phoenix. The top MSAs for the third and fourth quarters were Phoenix-Mesa, New York-Newark and Chicago.
