What are AACP Councils?

Members can join one of two Councils: The Council of Faculties or the Council of Deans, which represent and support the administrators, faculty, and professional staff at member institutions. Each Council provides input on programming at regional or national meetings, manages committees responsible for the development of reports and/or recommendations, and oversees robust online communities via AACP Connect.
